

MORAY COUNCIL (A940 GRANTOWN ROAD, FORRES) 40/30MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER 2022

Moray Council propose to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The general effect will be to introduce a 40mph speed limit buffer for vehicles entering Forres and amend the existing 30mph speed limit in line with current Guidelines and as specified in the Schedules to the order.



Following the approval of the Planning Application (19/00293 APP) submitted to Moray Council to build 112 residential units off Grantown Road, Forres, a Road Safety Audit identified a “risk of increase in severity of collision” on the A940 and recommended a 40mph speed limit to cover the development junction with the A940. This proposal is to introduce a 40mph speed limit to protect the development access and extend the 40mph limit into Forres to an appropriate location for a transition to 30mph. This amendment is in accordance with the procedure for reviewing speed limits agreed at the Economic Development and Infrastructure Services Committee on 13 October 2009 and in the interests of Road Safety.
